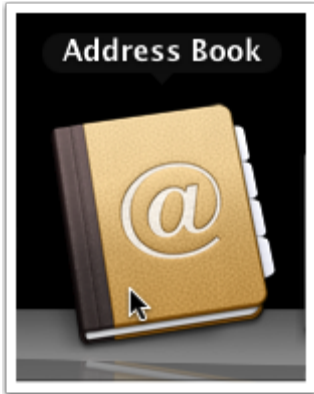


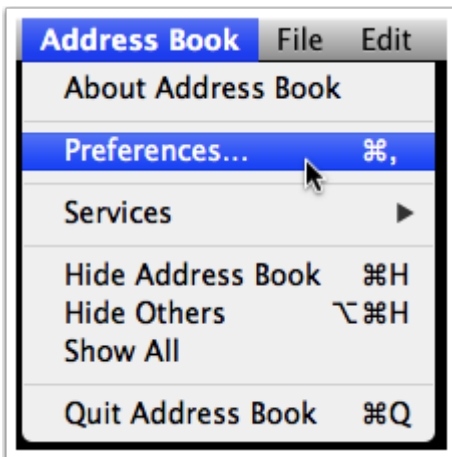
Adding CardDav to OS X Lion and Above

Open Address Book

Find the Address Book in Lion and Contacts in Mountain Lion and open it.

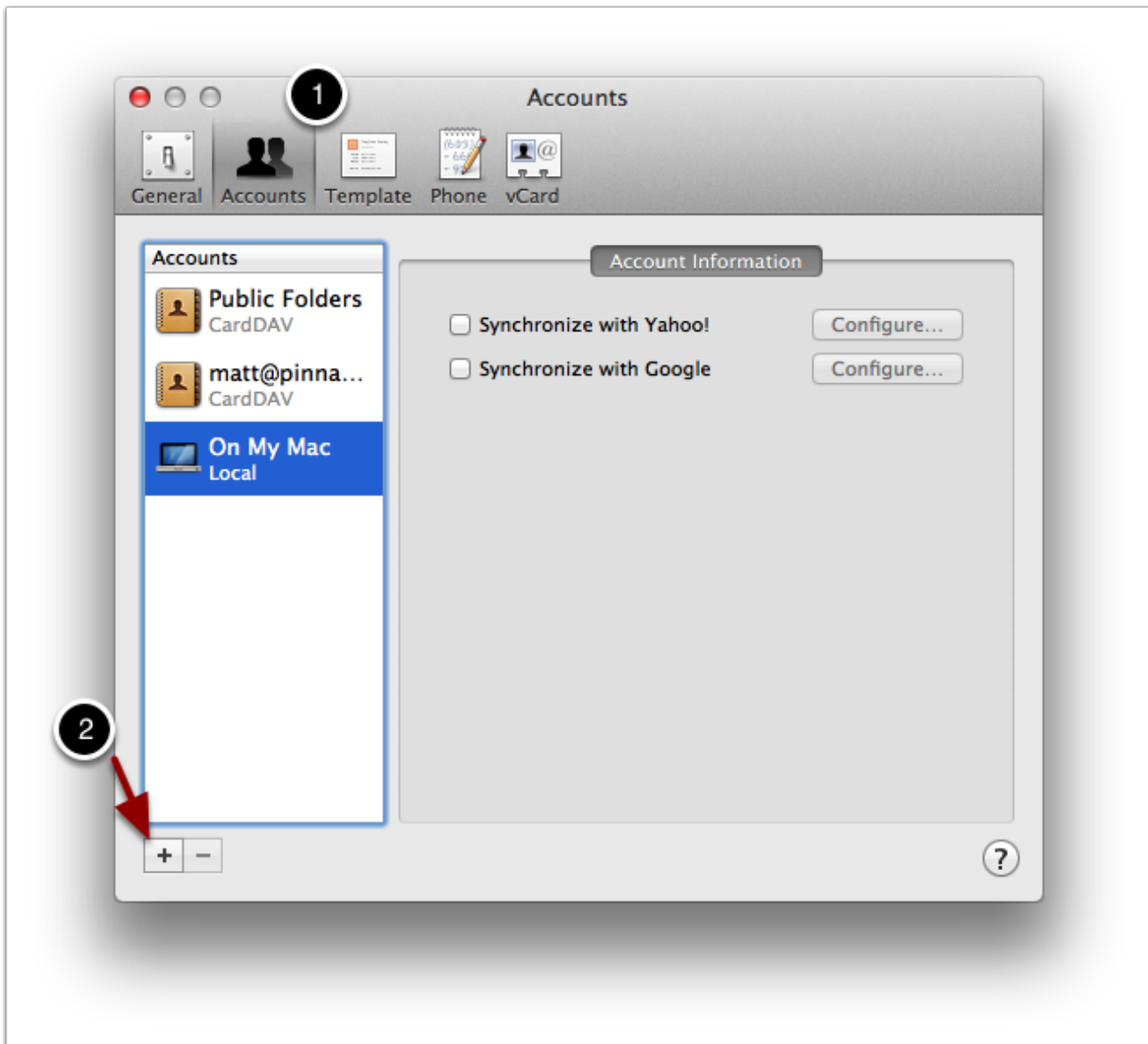


Open Preferences



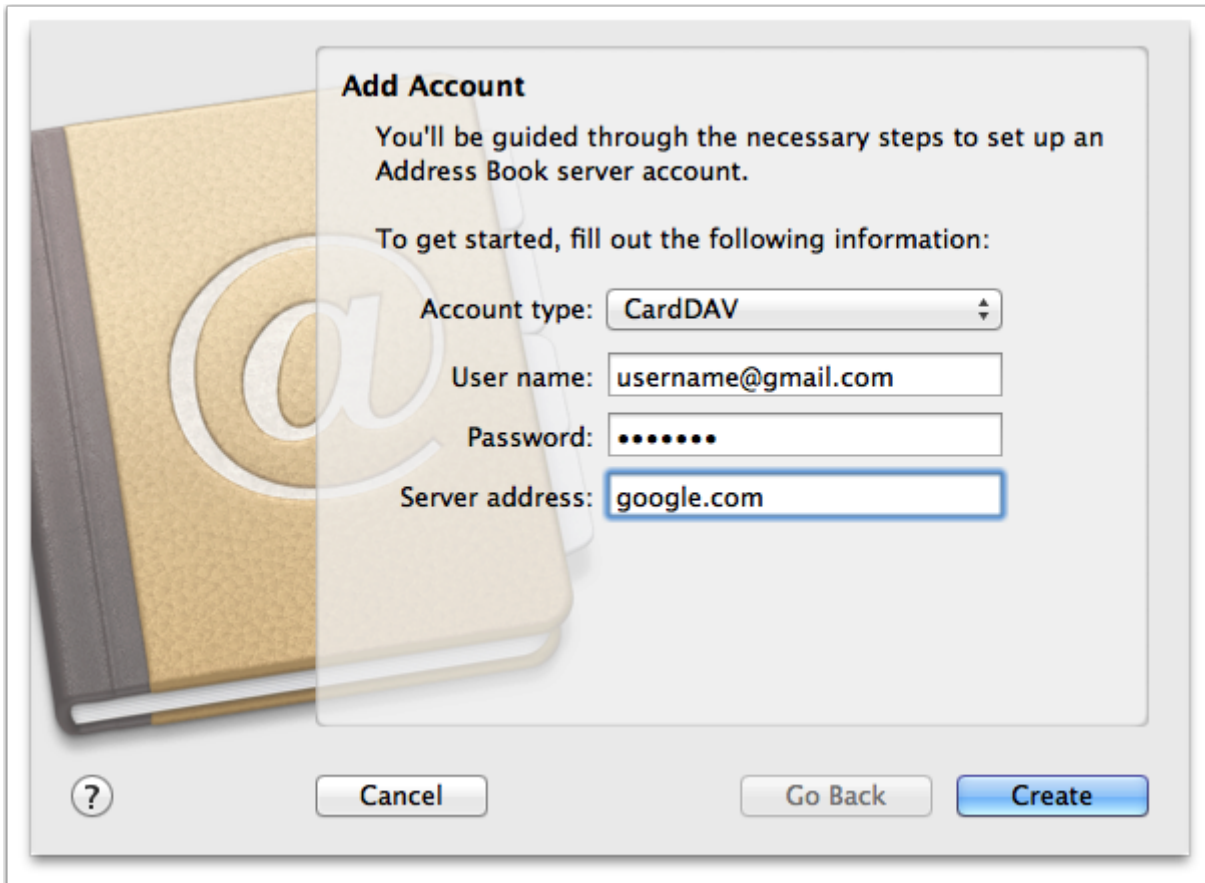
Select Accounts

1. Select Accounts
2. Hit the plus sign to add an account



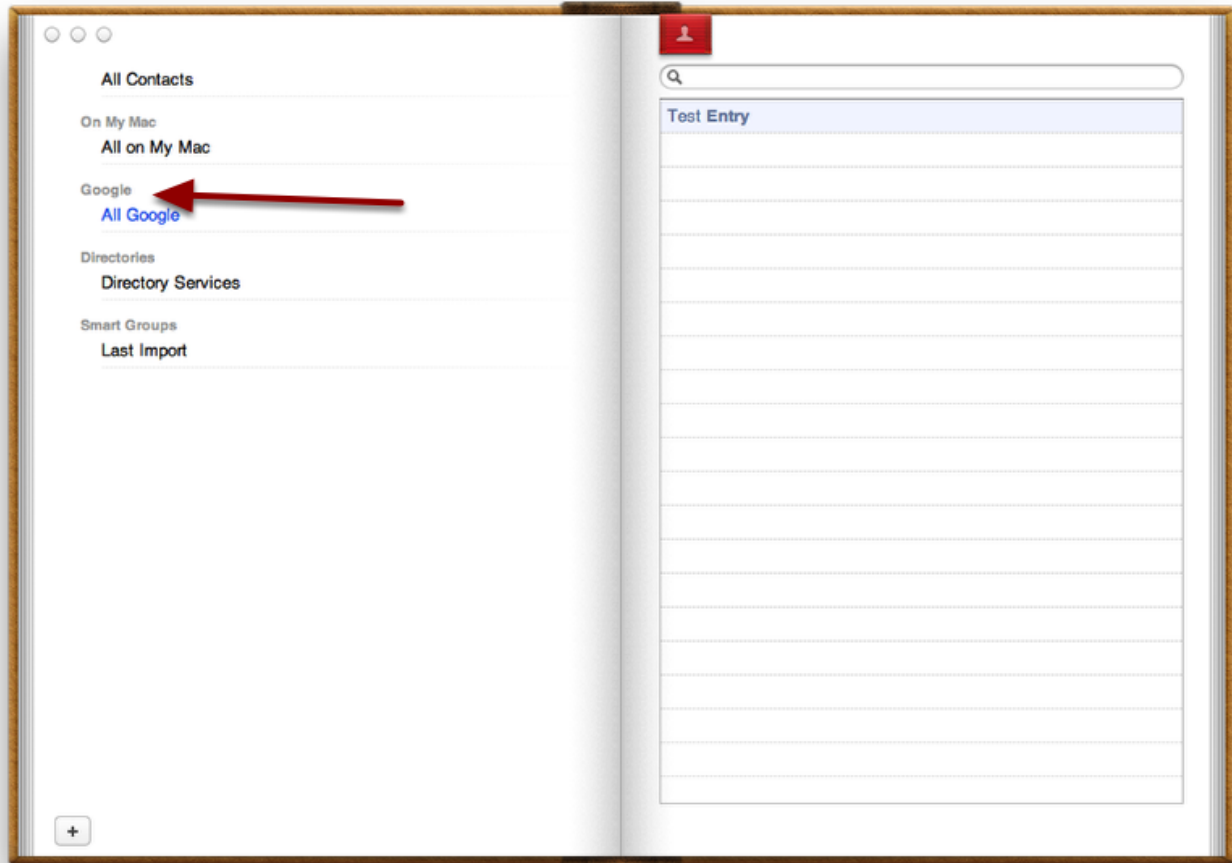
Add Your Information

1. Make sure the account type is CardDAV
2. Your User Name is the full account, so if you have a Google Apps account it would be yourname@abccompany.com where abccompany is replaced by your company name.
3. Enter your password, but if you have 2 step verification on you will need to generate an application specific password.
4. Server address is google.com



You Now Have Contacts Syncing.... But...

The big but is you will notice it comes up as Google at least on Lion. For some reason when you add the account if you already have Google checking your mail it changes the name of the account to Google. See the next step to fix this.

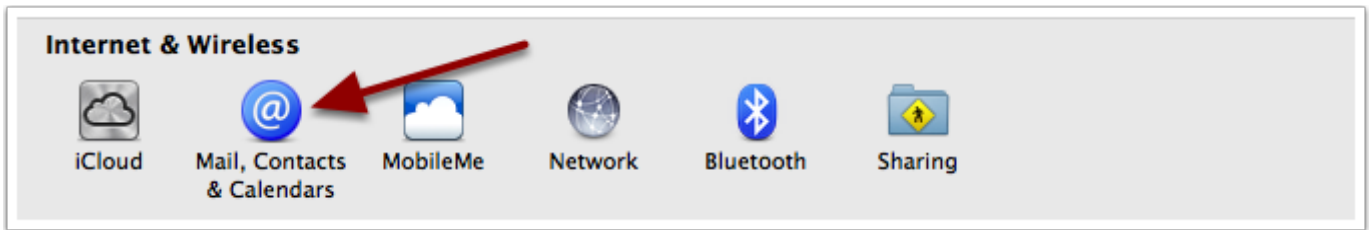

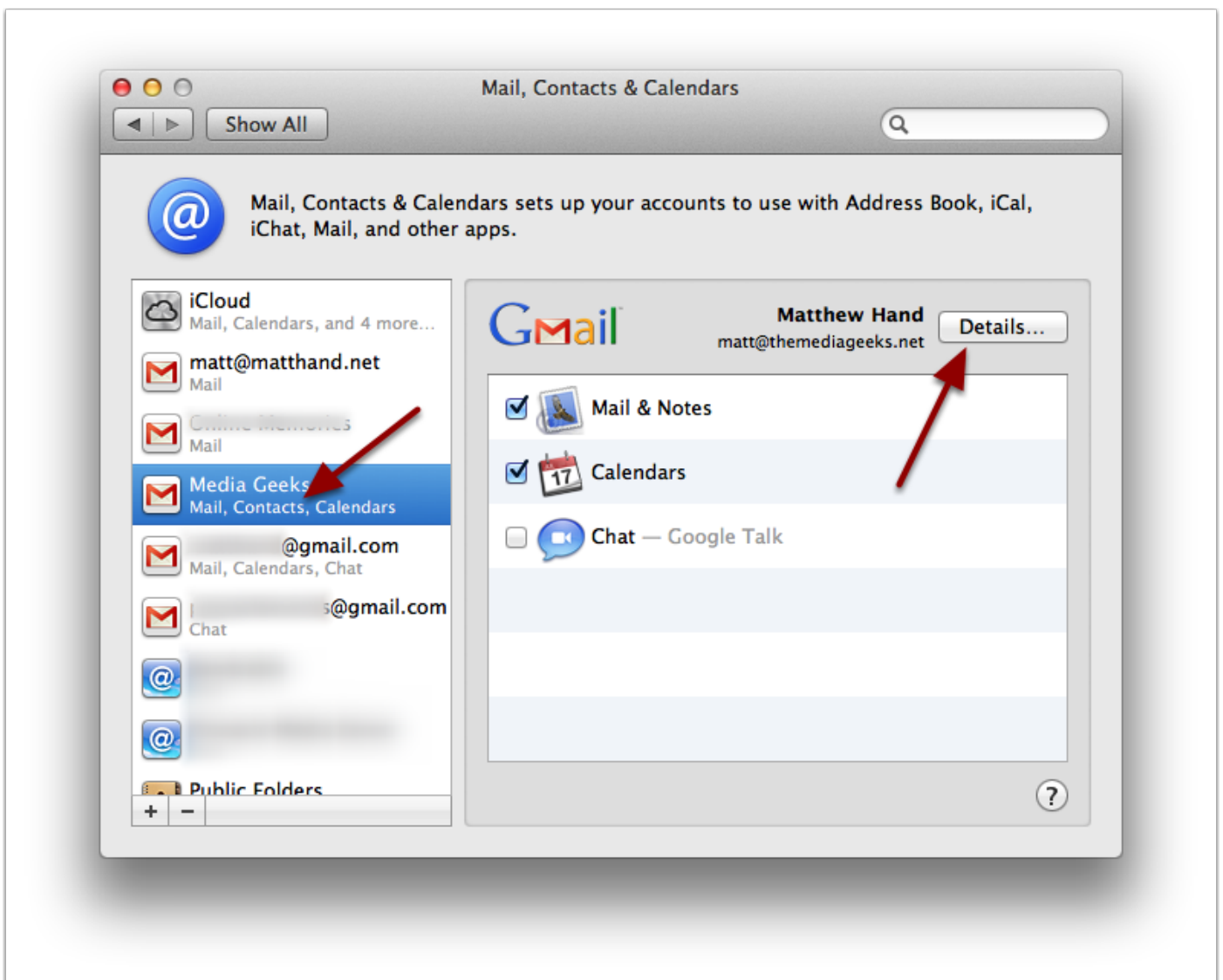

Find Your Account You Added Contacts Too

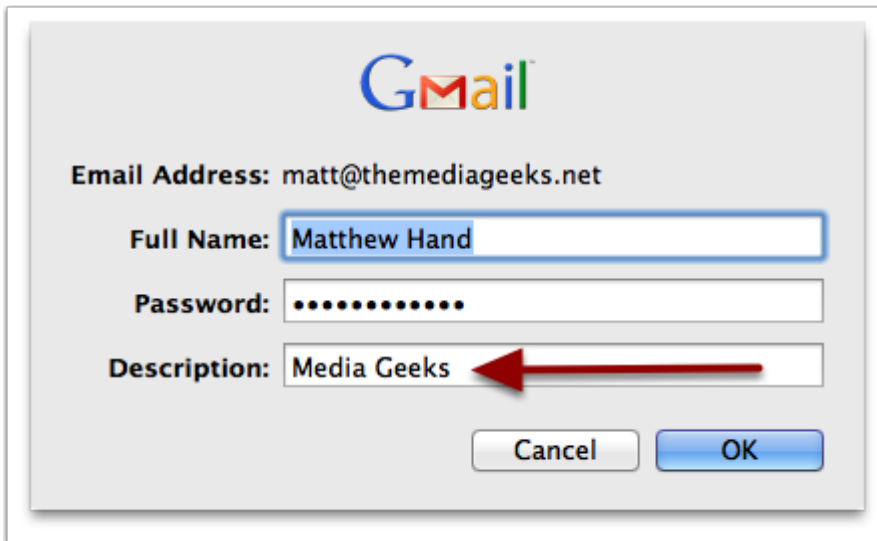
I added the contacts to Media Geeks account. In order for it to change in Contacts I have to modify the mail account name. Before we do that you will notice that Contacts are now apart of this account which until I added it it with the new CardDav worked it did not exist.

Click Details and proceed to the next step.



Change the Description

I know this seems strange and I guess it is a bug, but you need to erase and retype the Description. Click OK
