

# Adding CardDav to OS X Lion and Above

Find the Address Book in Lion and Contacts in Mountain Lion and open it.




## **Open Preferences**




#### **Select Accounts**

- 2. Hit the plus sign to add an account




#### **Add Your Information**

- 1. Make sure the account type is CardDAV
- 2. Your User Name is the full account, so if you have a Google Apps account it would be yourname@abccompany.com where abccompany is replaced by your company name.
- 3. Enter your password, but if you have 2 step verification on you will need to generate an application specific password.
- 4. Server address is google.com



## You Now Have Contacts Syncing.... But...

The big but is you will notice it comes up as Google at least on Lion. For some reason when you add the account if you already have Google checking your mail it changes the name of the account to Google. See the next step to fix this.





#### **Find Your Account You Added Contacts Too**


